Grant-Making Policy

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The purpose of this policy is to set out the current priorities for funding and the principles used by The Sir Peter Rigby Charitable Trust (“the Trust”) when awarding grant funding.

2. Current priorities

- 2.1. The Trust’s trustees take an active role in determining the priorities for funding in line with their strategic focus. These are currently education, digital inclusion, enterprise and food poverty.
- 2.2. The Trust is currently committed to three major projects and is not able to consider any further applications at this time.

3. Grant-making principles

- 3.1. The Trust’s trustees are collectively responsible for all decisions about awarding funding. Where there is a potential conflict of interest, the Trust’s Conflicts of Interest Policy will be followed.
- 3.2. The trustees may delegate some responsibilities to the Trust’s staff in line with the Scheme of Delegation.
- 3.3. Trustees reserve the right to apply special conditions to any grant awarded.
- 3.4. All funded organisations are expected to comply with the agreed schedule for monitoring and evaluation, as set out in their funding agreement.
